Sam Evans, Music Director of Teddington Choral Society since 2015, is a professional singer, conductor and teacher; he mentors several choirs and is closely associated with the Monteverdi Choir; he has performed with all the major professional UK choirs, including Polyphony, the Gabrieli

Consort, The Kings Consort, The Sixteen and the BBC Singers. He is in demand as a guest chorus master and workshop leader for choirs. He is a highly experienced singing teacher, now on the peripatetic staff at Westminster School, and teaches on the annual Eton Choral Courses, and for the National Youth Choirs of Great Britain.

Sam has a distinguished international career as a Baritone soloist: his repertoire encompasses opera, oratorio and song. He made his operatic debut at the Opéra Comique, Paris, and has performed at the BBC Proms, the Royal Albert Hall and the Barbican, London, the Concertgebouw, Amsterdam, and Sydney Opera House.



Arlene Rolph vocal coach

One of the most promising young mezzo sopranos of her generation Arlene has appeared at the Glyndebourne Festival, Scottish Opera, Welsh National Opera. Grange Park Opera, English Touring Opera, Music Theatre Wales, and enjoys an international reputation, having sung

at many high profile European concert venues.

Arlene is very active in creating and progressing educational and inspirational music projects. She is co-director and co- founder of a contemporary opera company and tours projects throughout the UK and abroad. She is a vocal teacher at Tonbridge School, Brighton College and has coached at the Royal Conservatoire for Scotland, National Youth Choir of Scotland and has held masterclasses in opera at Edinburgh Student Opera. Arlene also runs classical song and music workshops designed for babies through to adults.
