Job Description for The Musical Director of the Teddington Choral Society -TCS

Purpose of Role:	To lead the choir in rehearsal, performance and development in choral repertoire.

Principal Tasks:

1. Liaise with the committee in order to set the programme 12 months ahead and agree a music programme for concert performance at the end of each term.

period, for a mutual review at that time.

- 2. The repertoire should be appropriate for the concert, aid development of individuals and the choir & maintain and expand audience numbers.
- 3. Musical Director has final artistic control over the choice. The music selected should remain within the budget agreed by the Committee. Adjustments to be made to programmes if necessary.
- 4. Learn the music for the term
- 5. Conduct and teach music and performance skills for the term. Set and keep to a timetable for teaching all the music for that term/season.
- 6. Start each rehearsal with a warm-up.
- 7. Create an enjoyable evening for the singers. End on a 'high spot'.
- 8. At Concerts/Recitals. Conduct the dress rehearsal (usually on the same day as the performance) and conduct the performance.
- 9. Voice test singers for entry to TCS
- 10. With the approval of the committee, choose soloists and musicians and ensure they have a copy of the concert instructions.
- 11. Coach singers in foreign languages/dialects.
- 12. Work co-operatively with the Accompanist and other professional staff with split rehearsals where necessary. Work in unison with the Chair & committee.
- 13. Liaise within reason, any agency or individual required for the benefit of TCS such as 'fixing' musicians for a chamber orchestra.
- 14. Research and briefly inform the singers of the background to the music/composer
- 15. Attendance at the TCS AGM is required and Committee meetings desirable (at least 2 per year)

Person Specification

1. Have fluent English

- 2. The ability to work with an amateur choir of mixed ability.
- 3. Develop the knowledge and enthusiasm for the music that may be sung by this Choir.
- 4. Be able to produce a forward programme for music for the next 12 months.
- 5. Understand the techniques needed for teaching and learning.
- 6. Be able to encourage learning and capacity building with the singers.
- 7. Be able to rehearse the Choir with cheerfulness and with a sense of humour.
- 8. An outgoing likeable/extrovert personality.
- 9. Good, punctual communication skills.
- 10. Have reasonable IT skills, use of e mail.
- 11. Ability & willingness to work with colleagues/committee/deadlines/within budget.
- 12. Live within a reasonable travel distance of the London Borough of Richmond.

Musical Qualification.

- Ideally a graduate or experienced to a graduate level
- Experienced with singing/choirs/vocal technique
- Experience in conducting and working with other musicians
- Good knowledge of Classical repertoire, Jazz Standards and suitable Popular music.
- Ability to play the piano to a high standard. Able to cover should the accompanist be absent

Bonuses:

- Able to bring something 'different' to the Choir, networking connections in music world/invites to festivals/choir swaps etc.
- Composer/Arranger skills
